## A SLOW ESCAPE

A Slow Escape is the scenic travel journal, both hyper-theatrical and documentary, deriving from two walks from Norway to Venice - Catharine H. Kølle's journey in 1841 and Karen Røise Kielland's tracking of her in 2011. The results of the fieldwork reveal different strategies in the face of the unknown, shrouded in smoke and revealed in spotlight, with artist Tom Mason drawing from recollections.

Kølle walked at a time when Europe was in crisis. Karen finds the same. But Kølle went before the German Revolution of 1848 and the Industrial Revolution. She hiked through a rural pre-industrial empire, while Karen walked through an overgrown post-industrial European Union. 170 years have passed. Does Europe continually move forward? Why is progress associated with speed? How do I experience time? What is a long journey, a great distance, high speed? Is it possible to extend time by moving slowly? Can one truly touch upon a specific historical figure or time? How often does history repeat itself?

The performance is a confrontation with expectation, and the ability to imagine as the driving force; friend and sometimes foe. Drawings, objects and sound bring the room into motion, while the performer stands still on stage.
